Areas Of Consideration In Awarding Points For The Diving Competition

Each dive is composed of a starting position; approach; takeoff; flight and positions; and an entry into the water ---- (score the total dive)

- * Each judge shall award a diver a score of no more than 2½ to 4 if:
 - o The diver partially alters the position of a dive in flight
- * Each judge shall deduct ½ to 2 points from an award if the diver:
 - Crow hops feet leave the board then return to the board prior to a back/inward takeoff (actual flight of the dive)
 - Excessive oscillation the pressing of the feet downward causing the board to rise and fall more than 4 times before diving.
 - o Flight of the dive causes entry to the side of the board.
 - Twists manifestly from the board from a back/inward dive position, immediately twists off the board instead of rising up, over the board, by pressing the board down and then twisting.
 - o Spreads his/her knees in the tuck position.
- * Referee announces to all judges, "no more than 2" for:
 - Tuck position introduced in twisting dives other than 5152, 5221, 5231, 5321, and 5331
 - Head first dive hand/hands below the shoulders
 - Feet first dive hand/hands above the shoulders
 - Diver <u>hits the diving board</u> while executing the dive.
 - o Dive is <u>clearly executed</u> in the wrong position.
 - Diver does not attempt to come out from the tuck position.
- * Referee announces to scorers "Deduct 2 points from each judges' score" for:
 - A balk (a movement that interrupts a continuous execution of the dive)
 - o A violation of the forward approach or diver takes 3 steps and a hurdle; then:
 - 1. Oscillates the board before diving
 - 2. Bounces to end of the board before diving
- * Referee announces to all scorers & judges "Failed dive" for the following:
 - Does not assume a starting position
 - o On a feet first entry hands hit first
 - o On a head first entry feet hit first
 - Does not execute pike before twist in these half twist dives/pike position only (5111; 5211; 5311 and 5411)
 - o Falls off the board while executing the dive
 - o Executes the wrong dive or a dive not listed
 - o Commits 2 balks or repeats a dive
 - Is assisted by another person
 - Doesn't record the official description of the dive (Dive # and position)
 - Steps off the board after assuming the starting position
 - o Performs a dive requiring a forward approach from a standing position
 - o In dual meets, does not perform the voluntary dive first
 - In championship meet, does not perform dives as specified in the rules
 - o In twisting dives <u>Twists the shoulders 90 degrees more or less</u> than indicated on the score sheet when the diver's feet/hands contact the water
- * The diver shall be **disqualified** if, in the referee's judgment:
 - o The diver does not make a sincere attempt to perform the dive
 - o It becomes obvious the dives listed are too difficult for the diver
 - The diver unnecessarily delays in performing the dive
 - o The diver behaves in an unsportsmanlike manner
