Safety Procedure Recommendations

The following is a list of safety procedures, recommended by the representatives of the NWSC. Inc. to assure a safe meet:

- 1. There should be a minimum of two lifeguards on duty during the warm-up, and one during the meet.
- 2. Warm-up procedures should be adhered to.
- 3. Spectators should not be allowed near the starter's gun. An area should be roped off for the official.
- 4. Jumping/throwing into the pool after a meet should not be allowed.
- First aid supplies/emergency equipment such as ice packs, gloves and gauze pads, should be available at all facilities. HOST TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING SUPPLIES.
- 6. An emergency plan of action should be prepared and practiced, in the event of an accident. An accident report is strongly suggested.
