The new motion is to go back to the old set up of having the 8-under free relay, and the 10 & under and 14 & Under medley relays at the beginning of the All-Star Meet, and the 12 & Under and 18 & Under Freestyle relays at the end of the same meet. All relays would be swam short course, and the lane-lines will be changed by the staff of Lewisboro to accommodate the 25 yd course. Brenda Lyons (Yorktown) seconded the motion. Long discussion took place afterward. Each club was asked to vote: 20 voted for the new motion, 4 voted against it, 1 abstained. Motion passed.
