4. Dual Meet Results:

Congratulations to the following teams who will be moving up, or went undefeated: Willowbrook, Briarcliff (up to Division I) Bedford Village (up to Division II), Ossining (up to Division III) Whippoorwill (up to Division IV)

The following teams will be moving down: Pleasantville (to Division II), Pound Ridge (to Division III). Teams in Division III & IV will not be moving down, in order to realign the Divisions. The divisions now have the following numbers: Division I (6 teams); Division III (5 teams); Division IV (5 teams); Division V (5 teams). Meets were completed in a timely manner!

9. Old Business:

+Swim Across America on Sunday, July 14 – Chappaqua raised \$36,000! That's a 20% increase from last year. 80 swimmers participated which was a 33% increase from last year. Olympic Silver medalist *BOBBY HACKETT* gave a swim clinic.

Lakeside hosted a swim. Chappaqua and Lakeside were asked to do a brief write-up (to include pictures) and send it to the web site.

10. New Business -

+Disability Rules – the NWSC Executive Committee adopted the USA Swimming "Guidelines for Officiating Swimmers with a Disability," in July. An email was sent with attachments on Thursday, July 18. (*The Board strongly urges Coaches to notify the NWSC immediately of anyone who might be competing with a disability*.) A copy of these rules will be put on the web site. These rules can also the guidelines are in the USA Swimming 2013 Rulebook, which can be found at:

to "RULES & REGULATIONS," then scroll to "USA Swimming Rulebook." Click on that and a PDF copy will come up. The ruling begins on page 53 of the rule book (Article 105). You can also find them in the MINI-RULEBOOK, which is also under USA SWIMMING RULEBOOK. A motion was made to formally adopt the USA Swimming "Guidelines for Officiating Swimmers with a Disability" by Meg Kaplan and seconded by Bedford Hills. *All in Favor*.

+*Proposal # 1:* Girls and Boys 14 & Under Medley Relay to be run as the first event. Motion by Meg Kaplan, seconded by MKMP. We do this event in champs, why not in a dual meet...

Discussion ensured.

2 YES: 17 NO. Motion did not pass.

+*Proposal* # 2: Girls and Boys 14 & Under Medley Relay <u>EXHIBITION</u> and have a one year trial period. Motion made by Bedford Hills and seconded by Pocantico Hills. Discussion ensued.

2 YES: 17 NO. Motion did not pass.

+*Proposal* # 3: Girls and Boys 8 & Under Freestyle Relay to be run before the 11 & under relay. Motion made by MKCC and seconded by Pound Ridge. We do this event in champs, so why not in a dual meet...

Discussion ensued.

3 YES: 16 NO. Motion did not pass

+Proposal # 4: To undo last year's new diving rule, where diving is exhibition and does not count as an event. Motion made by Michael Panzarino and seconded by Yorktown. Discussion ensued: Due to this Rule, divers from Mount Pleasant could not participate because they did not have enough meets.

11 YES: 5 NO: 2 ABSTENTIONS. Motion passed

- + *Proposal # 5:* Revert back to the High School rule if a team does not have diving, and the opposing team does: diving is allowed, it counts as an event, and team points are scored. (Up to 3 places may be scored) Motion made by Pocantico Hills and seconded by MKMP.
- 9 YES; 6 NO; 3 ABSTENTIONS. Motion passed.
- 11. Next Meeting: Monday May 12, 2014 or Tuesday May 13, 2014
- **12. Adjournment**: motion to adjourn by Cortlandt and seconded by Windmill. Meeting adjourned at 8:24pm. *All in favor.*
