II. Job Summary

Manages and supervises new 3.5 million dollar aquatics facilities. Position runs Mid May to Mid-September; advanced pre-season planning/meetings as required.

III. Experience/Expectations

- 1. Must possess and maintain the following certifications:
 - a. Certified Pool Operator, Lifeguard, CPR and First Aid.
- 2. Broad knowledge and experience in pool chemistry, operation and management.
- 3. Monitors and coordinates pool safety programs and risk management.
- 4. Thoroughly understands specific state and local laws and statutes regarding pool safety and inspections.
- 5. Responsible for the enforcement of all operational policies and procedures, rules and regulations ensuring the safety of our members and guests.

IV. Job Tasks (Duties)

- 1. Assists in opening and closing duties for seasonal operation.
- 2. Assists in supervising 10-15 seasonal pool workers.
- 3. Hires, orients, trains and supervises all lifeguards; ensures required certifications.
- 4. Enforces and abides by club's emergency protocols.
- 5. Develops and implements pool safety program and schedules staff to provide adequate protection for members and their guests.
- 6. Formulates weekly work schedules and pool rotation schedules for all employees.
- 7. Requisitions pool chemicals and all departmental supplies.
- 8. Maintains proper chemical balance in pools in accordance with Health Department regulations.
- 9. Maintains all necessary records including pool chemicals and accident reports.
- 10. Maintains mechanical equipment in coordination with the club's maintenance department.
- 11. Works inter departmentally to ensure a clean, manicured and sanitary environment.
- 12. Ensures accurate member verification & guest registration.
- 13. Enforces club rules of safety and conduct.
- 14. Assist in the coordination of programs and special events as outlined by management.
- 15. Any other duties as needed
